# Band

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade (No Prior experience required)

- Complete a series of listening activities on pitch, harmony, melody, and rhythm.
  - o Recognize the difference between high and low pitches.
  - Recognize whether or not two melodies, harmonies, or rhythms are the same.

### 7th Grade Band

- Perform Concert Bb, Concert F, and Concert Eb scales one octave with arpeggio.
  Percussionist (same scales as above) plus multiple bounce, 9 stroke, rolls, flam, paradiddle
- All students must be able to count and play 8<sup>th</sup> note rhythms.
- Perform a prepared piece on a major instrument.

# Dance

#### 6th and 7th Grade

- Learn the choreography on the following website <a href="https://sites.google.com/clayton.k12.ga.us/mdrsota-fine-arts/theatre-dance/dance?authuser=0">https://sites.google.com/clayton.k12.ga.us/mdrsota-fine-arts/theatre-dance/dance?authuser=0</a>
- Record yourself completing the choreography
- Dancer must be in solid black
- Dance shoes (optional)

# Guitar

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade (No Prior experience required)

- Complete a series of listening activities on pitch, harmony, melody, and rhythm.
  - Recognize the difference between high and low pitches.
  - Recognize whether or not two melodies, harmonies, or rhythms are the same.

#### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Guitar

- Be able to play e minor 1-octave scale
- Sight-read a 4 measure excerpt.
- Demonstrate knowledge of beginning note values, key signatures, musical symbols.
- Perform a prepared solo.

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# Media Arts

### 6th and 7th Grade

- Have 2-3 pieces of your best work that you have created.
- Create a logo for your favorite item.
- Write 3-5 sentences answering the question: Why do you want to be a part of the Media Arts magnet program at M. D. Roberts School of the Arts?

# Orchestra

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade (No Prior experience required)

- Complete a series of listening activities on pitch, harmony, melody, and rhythm.
  - Recognize the difference between high and low pitches.
  - Recognize whether or not two melodies, harmonies, or rhythms are the same.

### 7th Grade

- Be able to play D major 1-octave scale on the violin, viola, cello, or bass.
- Demonstrate knowledge of beginning note values, key signatures, musical symbols.
- Perform a prepared solo on your violin, viola, cello or bass.

# Piano

- Complete a series of listening activities on pitch, harmony, melody, and rhythm.
  - o Recognize the difference between high and low pitches.
  - Recognize whether or not two melodies, harmonies, or rhythms are the same.

# **Theatre**

### 6th and 7th Grade

- Perform a prepared one minute monologue. (See the Theatre page on the website for possible monologue choices) or <u>click here.</u>
- Show characterization with facial expression, vocal expression, and body movements.
- Participate in a teacher-led work session or an improvisation.
- Be prepared to perform the following songs:
- Males: "Under the Sea" from The Little Mermaid or "Gaston" from Beauty and the Beast.
- Females: "Fabulous" from High School Musical 2 or "Good Morning Baltimore" from Hairspray.
- 7th-grade students should know the stage directions and basic theatre terminology.

# Visual Arts

## 6th and 7th Grade

- Provide 2 3 examples of the student's best artwork they've created (can include photographs or 3D artwork, at least one composition has to be drawn).
- Write 3-5 sentences answering the question: Why do you want to be a part of the Visual Arts magnet program at M. D. Roberts School of the Arts?
- Still life drawing exercise during the live audition.

# **Vocal Music**

#### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade (no prior experience required)

- Complete a series of listening activities on pitch, harmony, melody, and rhythm.
  - o Recognize the difference between high and low pitches.
  - Recognize whether or not two melodies, harmonies, or rhythms are the same.

### 7th Grade

- Rising 7th graders: Sing "America the Beautiful" or "My Country Tis of Thee"
- Participate in teacher-led activities with rhythmic and tonal memory examples.
- Rising 7th-grade students should be able to identify note values and basic music symbols.
- Rising 7th-grade students should be able to sight-read in stepwise motion with dotted rhythms present.
